For the period 1 January 2025 to 30 June 2025

This Half-Yearly Report is being published in terms Prospects MTF Rule 4.11.12 issued by the Malta Financial Services Authority and the Prevention of Financial Markets Abuse Act, 2005. The Half-Yearly Report comprises the unaudited condensed consolidated interim financial statements for the six months ended 30 June 2025 prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards adopted for use in the EU for interim financial statements (International Accounting Standard 34, "Interim Financial Reporting"). The condensed consolidated interim financial statements have not been audited or reviewed by the Group's independent auditors. The comparative statement of financial position has been extracted from the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2024 and restated as disclosed further in Note 2.

Principal activities

Klikk Finance p.l.c ('Klikk') is a publicly listed company on the Malta Stock Exchange and parent company of the Klikk Group ('Group'), which consists of Klikk and Klikk Limited, a fully owned subsidiary.

The principal activity of Klikk is that of a finance and holding company. The Group's core operations are carried out through Klikk Limited, which manages two computer retail outlets located on the Birkirkara By-Pass and tal-Barrani Road, Żejtun. These outlets cater for both retail and corporate clients, offering a wide range of IT-related products and services.

Review of Financial Performance

The year 2025 marks a transitional period for the Group, as it realigns operations under the new ownership of GO plc and sets the foundation for its long-term strategy. This strategy focuses on driving sustainable revenue growth, expanding into new market niches, strengthening the Group's competitive positioning, and channelling investment into business segments with the highest strategic value and growth potential.

Revenue for the six-month period ended 30 June 2025 increased by 21% year-on-year, rising from €3.81 million in 2024 to €4.61 million in 2025. This growth reflects early commercial traction following the Group's strategic shift and integration into the GO Group.

Gross margin declined to 11.2% compared to 14.9% in the same period last year, primarily due to inflationary pressures and a rise in the cost of sales. Higher purchase volumes contributed to this increase, as the Group scales operations in anticipation of future growth.

Operating expenses also rose during the period, with administrative costs increasing as a result of higher payroll and investment in organisational capabilities. These increases are aligned with the Group's scale-up efforts and represent forward-looking investment in people, systems, and infrastructure rather than short-term inefficiencies.

The Group reported an operating loss of €147,068 for the period, compared to €13,306 in the first half of 2024. While the short-term financial impact reflects the upfront cost of repositioning the business, management remains confident that these investments will drive improved performance and profitability over the medium to long term.

1 General information

Klikk Finance p.l.c ("the Company") is a limited liability company domiciled and incorporated in Malta. The condensed consolidated interim financial statements of the Company as at 30 June 2025 and for the six-month period then ended comprise the Company and its subsidiary Klikk Limited (together referred to as the "Group").

The consolidated financial statements of the Group as at and for the year ended 31 December 2024 are available upon request from the Company's registered office at Triq Hal Tarxien, Zejtun, ZTN 3000, Malta. They are also available for viewing on its website at www.klikk.com.mt.

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements were approved for issue by the Board of Directors on 12 August 2025.

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements have not been audited or reviewed by the Group's independent auditors.

2 Basis of preparation

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements as at and for the six-month period ended 30 June 2025 have been prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards ("IFRSs") as adopted by the EU applicable to interim financial reporting (International Accounting Standard 34, "Interim Financial Reporting"). The condensed consolidated interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the annual financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2024, which have been prepared in accordance with IFRSs as adopted by the EU.

Financial position of the Group and the Group's cash flow forecasting process:

As of 30 June 2025, the Group's current liabilities exceeded its current assets by €209,000, (2024: current assets exceed current liabilities by €114,000). This is primarily due to the higher investments in inventories in line with the strategy.

However, the Group anticipates generating earnings in the upcoming financial year through its operations. This expected performance is projected to effectively cover the Group's cash flow and liquidity requirements. Based on the Group's cash flow projections and the financial statements' published data, the Group shall consistently generate cash flow that exceeds the current shortfall of €209,000. This provides confidence in the Group's ability to meet its short-term liquidity needs.

Looking forward the Group anticipates enhanced sales transactions and greater revenues. This means that the Group is expected to expand further its operations which shall lead to increased short term cashflows shortfalls.

These factors are reflected in the Group's cash flow forecasts together with cash management facilities, reinforcing the Group's capacity to manage its liquidity effectively and provide the Group with adequate headroom over the going concern assessment period. The accounting policies applied are consistent with those of the annual financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2024, as described in those annual financial statements.

New and amended standards adopted by the Group

A number of amended standards became applicable for the current reporting period. There is no impact on the adoption of these revisions on the Group's accounting policies and on the Group's financial results and financial position.

Impact of standards issued but not yet applied by the Group

Certain new standards, amendments and interpretations to existing standards have been published by the date of authorisation for issue of these financial statements but are mandatory for the Group's accounting periods beginning after 1 January 2024. The Group has not early adopted these revisions to the requirements of IFRSs as adopted by the EU, and the Company's directors are of the opinion that there are no requirements that will have a possible significant impact on the Group's financial statements in the period of initial application.

Prior Period Error

During the current financial year, management identified prior period errors relating to the incorrect recognition and measurement of certain assets and liabilities. These included (i) inventory items carried at cost despite having a lower net realisable value (NRV), (ii) trade receivables deemed unrecoverable but not previously impaired, and (iii) incorrect creditor balances due to incomplete records. These errors, in their totality, have resulted in an overstatement of assets and understatement of liabilities and have been corrected retrospectively in accordance with IAS 8 Accounting Policies, Changes in Accounting Estimates and Errors, with restatements made to the comparative financial information presented.

These errors have been corrected by restating each affected financial statement line item for the prior periods as follows:
